WATERTOWN 8 COOPERSTOWN 5

COOPERSTOWN, N.Y. - Brandon Cipolla (Holy Cross) and Jordan Enos (Holy Cross) each belted home runs and the Wizards scored five unanswered runs to earn a comeback victory against the Hawkeyes at Doubleday Field. Cooperstown's Chris Blanton (CSU Monterey Bay) erased a 3-2 Watertown lead in the fifth with a two-RBI single and Bradley Vanderglas (NKU) added another Hawkeye score in the sixth to put the home side ahead 5-3. Jordan Enos slugged a solo home run in the seventh and Donald Walter (CPP) began a four-run Wizards' rally in the eighth with an RBI triple. Walter scored on a base hit from Derek Hagy (UTPA) and Brandon Cipolla followed with a two-run clout. Watertown relievers Drew Quinney (Savannah State) and Jonathan Perez (St. Mary's, Texas) tossed three scoreless innings to seal the victory. Jordan Enos went 3-for-3 with two RBI and two runs scored, Donald Walter added three hits and two runs and Chris Glynn (UW Parkside) had two RBI. Bradley Vanderglas and Chris Blanton were the top Hawkeye marksmen both with three hits, one RBI and one run scored.

GLENS FALLS 9 ONEONTA 5

ONEONTA, N.Y. - Mike Vigliarolo (Saint Louis) and Alberto Morales (Clarendon) drove in four runs and the Golden Eagles outscored the Outlaws 5-1 over the final six innings to earn a Fourth of July victory in front of 4,412 fans at Damaschke Field. The Oneonta crowd was the largest in the PGCBL this season. The fireworks began not after dark but in the first three innings where the Golden Eagles and Outlaws scored early and often to the tune of a 4-4 stalemate through three frames. Glens Falls broke the deadlock in the fifth with three runs; Morales keyed the rally with a double that plated Vigliarolo and then he scored on a Kevin Meyers (NE Okla. A&M) RBI single. Vigliarolo, the league leader in RBI, slammed the door shut for the Golden Eagles with a two-RBI single in the ninth. Glens Falls relievers Jordan Keyser (Skidmore), Wes Judish (San Diego) and Jared Cheek (Ga. Southern) each tossed one shutout inning and starter Brandon Magallones (Northwestern) yielded just two earned runs in six frames. Seven of nine Golden Eagles had at least one hit led by Ross Kivett (Kansas State) who went 3-for-5 with two runs scored and one RBI. Vigliarolo, Morales and Meyers all had two hits and Chase Griffin (Ga. Southern) scored twice. Shane Crain (Louisville) topped the Outlaws' charge with a 4-for-5 performance. The victory also marked the 1,300th career coaching win for Glens Falls manager John Mayotte.

Division Format

All nine teams play in one nine-team division. PGCBL teams in 2012 include the Albany Dutchmen, Amsterdam Mohawks, Cooperstown Hawkeyes, Elmira Pioneers, Glens Falls Golden Eagles, Mohawk Valley DiamondDawgs, Newark Pilots, Oneonta Outlaws and Watertown Wizards.

Eligibility Requirements: Player must have remaining collegiate eligibility to participate.

Roster Limit: 30 players

Playoffs: August 3 - August 9

Playoff Teams: Four, the top four teams in the standings at the end of the regular season qualify for the playoffs.

Format: Two rounds, each contested in a best-of-three series. The playoff semifinals will run from August 3 through August 5 and those will be followed by the PGCBL Championship Series which will take place from August 7 through August 9. In the divisional playoffs, the higher seed will host the first and third game (if necessary) of the series and the lower seed will host the second game. The same format will be used in the finals with the higher-seeded team hosting the first and third game (if necessary and the lower-seeded team hosting the second game.
