Roster Limits: 35 players

Eligibility Requirements: Must have remaining collegiate athletic eligibility.

(Exception, each team may add to their roster two players who are at least 18 years of age, graduated from high school and have enrolled in college.)

Playoffs: July 31 – August 7

Playoff Teams: The top three teams in each division will qualify for the postseason.

Format: Teams will be seeded based on finish in the regular season standings in their respective divisions. Both the PGCBL East and West will have seeds 1-3. The opening round of the divisional playoffs will feature two winner-take-all games pitting the second seed against the third seed at the site of the second seed. The winner of the game will advance to the divisional finals to play the number one seed in a best-of-three series format. In the division finals, the one seed will host Game 1 and Game 3 (if necessary). The winners of the two divisional finals series will then meet in the PGCBL Championship Series. The highest remaining seed will have home-field advantage in the second and third games. If both teams have the same seed, the team with the best winning percentage will receive home-field advantage.

2014 Season in Review



Regular Season Recap:

The Amsterdam Mohawks had the most wins in PGCBL history, finishing with a 36-11 record as they won the East Division by a comfortable nine games. The Mohawks led all teams in batting average, team ERA and fielding percentage. The Newark Pilots won the West Division by 1.5 games, as they finished the regular season with a 27-19 record. Mike Carter (Adirondack) won the league batting title, hitting .430 for the Trail Blazers. Bryson Hough (Elmira) posted a 1.02 ERA for the Pioneers, while Jayson Yano (Newark) went 6-2 for the Pilots with a 1.35 ERA, taking home the 2014 Pitcher of the Year Award. Josh Gardiner (Amsterdam) finished the season with a .415 batting average and 16 stolen bases as he was named the 2014 Player of the Year.

Postseason Recap:

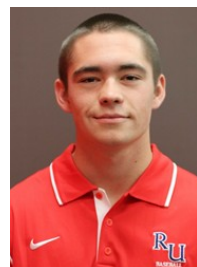
In the first round of the 2014 PGCBL Playoffs, the Mohawk Valley DiamondDawgs topped the Albany Dutchmen, 3-2, in the East behind stellar pitching from Nick Petrella. In the West, the Elmira Pioneers defeated the Watertown Rams for the second straight postseason behind a strong outing from Bryson Hough. In the WDCS, Elmira won game one in Newark, but wound up losing the next two games of the series as the Pilots advanced to the PGCBL Championship Series. Amsterdam won game one of the EDCS at home on a walk-off fielder's choice and went on to sweep Mohawk Valley to advance to the franchise's fourth-straight PGCBL Championship Series. Newark jumped out to an early lead in game one of the championship series, but Amsterdam rebounded and went on to win 9-3 at home. In game two, Mohawks starter Taylor Blatch dominated on the bump, tossing a complete game with nine strikeouts, leading the Mohawks to a 12-1 win and a third-straight PGCBL championship.

2013 Season in Review



Regular Season Recap:

The Amsterdam Mohawks had the best record during the regular season, finishing 31-16 as they won the East Division by a comfortable 4 games. The Mohawks led all teams in batting average, while finishing second in team ERA behind the Glens Falls Golden Eagles, who posted a combined 3.31 ERA. The Watertown Rams won the West Division by 6.5 games, as they finished the regular season with a 29-19 record. Michael Pierson (Utica) won the league batting title, hitting .404 for the Brewers. Dylan Collett (Albany) posted a 1.71 ERA for the Dutchmen, while Eann Cox (Cooperstown) went 6-0 for the Hawkeyes, taking home the 2013 Pitcher of the Year Award. John Nogowski (Amsterdam) finished the season with a .365 batting average and 79 total bases as he was named the 2013 Player of the Year.

Postseason Recap:

The 2013 PGCBL Playoffs was filled with excitement. The postseason began with Albany defeating Mohawk Valley in 11 innings to advance to the East Division Championship Series, where they would face the Amsterdam Mohawks. The Elmira Pioneers beat the Newark Pilots 5-0 behind 8 scoreless innings from Victor Diaz to advance to the West Division Championship Series. In the WDCS, Elmira won game one in Watertown in 14 innings and went on to sweep the Rams two game to none. Amsterdam won game one of the EDCS at home before losing game two on the road in 10 innings on an Anthony Marks walk-off single for Albany. Amsterdam won the deciding game three 9-4 to advance to the PGCBL Championship. The Mohawks won game one over the Pioneers 6-3 before losing game two in Elmira 9-7. In the winner-take-all game three, Mohawks starter Matt Snyder fired 8.1 innings, only allowing one run to lead Amsterdam to its second consecutive PGCBL Championship.

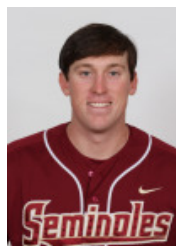

2012 Season in Review



Regular Season Recap:

The Amsterdam Mohawks had the best record during the regular season, finishing 35-12, 8 games ahead of the next best team, the Glens Falls Golden Eagles. The Newark Pilots, Mohawk Valley DiamondDawgs and Oneonta Outlaws all finished the season with records above .500. Glens Falls led the league in team batting average, hitting .294. Amsterdam finished the season with a 3.34 team ERA, best in the league. The Mohawks also struck out 420 batters, leading the league. Glens Falls second baseman Ross Kivett hit .401 for the Golden Eagles, leading the league as he took home the Player of the Year award. Amsterdam right-hander Chandler Shepherd and Watertown left-hander Rene Solis both finished with 1.31 ERAs to lead the league. Shepherd went 7-0 with 50 strikeouts to win the Pitcher of the Year award.

Postseason Recap:

In the first round of the 2012 PGCBL Playoffs, the number one seed Amsterdam Mohawks faced the number four seed Mohawk Valley DiamondDawgs, while the number two seed Glens Falls Golden Eagles clashed with the number three seed Newark Pilots. In game one of the Amsterdam-Mohawk Valley series, the DiamondDawgs won 5-3 in 11 innings on a David del Grande 2-RBI double. Amsterdam won game two handily, defeating Mohawk Valley 10-1. The pivotal third game was postponed due to rain before being played on August 6. Amsterdam starter Mark Leiter hurled a complete game without allowing an earned run as the Mohawks won 4-2. In the other series, Glens Falls won game one over Newark 6-5 with the help of 5 first inning runs. The Golden Eagles scored 2 runs in the top of the ninth to defeat the Pilots and advance to the PGCBL Championship. Amsterdam won game one of the championship 7-1 and went on to sweep Glens Falls with Chandler Shepherd picking up the win in game two. It was Amsterdam's first PGCBL Championship.

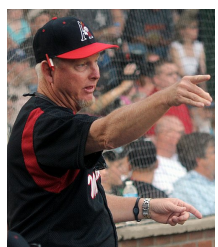

2011 Season in Review



Regular Season Recap:

The Glens Falls Golden Eagles had the best record in the regular season, finishing 31-17 as they won the East Division by a half game over the Amsterdam Mohawks. The Golden Eagles were second in the league in team ERA behind the Mohawks, but led the league with 430 strikeouts. Amsterdam led the league with a .288 team batting average. In the West Division, the Cooperstown Hawkeyes also won their division by a mere half game. The Hawkeyes were led by Bryan Aanderud, who finished tied for the batting title (.379) with Ryan Normoyle of the Elmira Pioneers. Watertown Wizard outfielder Erick Gaylord finished the season with a .360 batting average, while leading the league with 10 home runs and 42 RBIs as he took home Player of the Year honors. Newark Pilots starter Dominick Ruscitti ended the campaign 6-1 with a 1.82 ERA, earning him the Pitcher of the Year award.

Postseason Recap:

The first round of the 2011 PGCBL Playoffs matched the Cooperstown Hawkeyes with the Newark Pilots and the Amsterdam Mohawks against the Glens Falls Golden Eagles. In game one between Cooperstown and Newark, the Hawkeyes used a seventh inning inside-the-park grand slam from Ben Miller to win 6-2. Newark held off a late rally by the Hawkeyes in game two, winning 3-2. In the winner-take-all game three, Newark scored four runs in the third and got 7.1 solid innings from starter Dominick Ruscitti to advance to the PGCBL Championship. In the East Division, Amsterdam scored runs in the eighth and ninth to come back and win 4-3. The Mohawks swept the series on a Matt Mack walk-off single to move on to face Newark in the PGCBL Championship. Amsterdam took game one of the series behind Josh Alexander's 2 RBIs. In game one of a double-header held in Amsterdam, Newark scored in the top of the ninth to win 4-3. In the deciding third game, Newark pulled away late to win 7-4 and clinch the first PGCBL Championship.

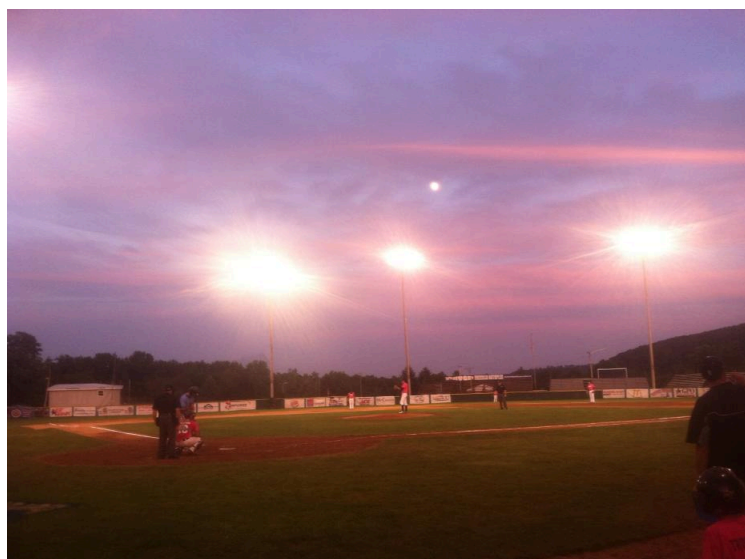
